Computer aided design, aeronautical construction and numerous prototypes have contributed to the creation of the Ultimate Off-Road Camper. Everything you need to take on your adventure will fit into the lines of the Ultimate, even your dinghy and outboard. The entire body, lounge, galley, lid and components of the Ultimate are hand moulded from high tech materials resulting in an extremely strong and low maintenance composite structure that will endure for decades. The chassis is fabricated from high tensile Duragal steel resulting in excellent strength and performance in all off-road extremes. The Ultimate's aerodynamic profile ensures minimal damage through deflected stones. The tare weight is only 850kg, allowing for greater payloads, optimised fuel economy and safer cruising.
